Job Title: SENIOR WATER/WASTEWATER OPERATOR

Job Summary:

The Senior Water/ Wastewater Operator reports directly to the District Manager and is responsible for supervising the Southern District operators. This position oversees operation and maintenance of the Company's contract operated water/wastewater supply, treatment, storage facilities, and distribution systems to ensure compliance with local, state, and federal requirements.

Work Performed:

- Act as a backup to the District Manager.
- Supervise the operation of production and distribution systems in an assigned area.
- Provide customer service, which includes handling water and wastewater complaints and mechanical problems.
- Prepare Work Orders for the District and oversees repairs/upgrades for all companies.
- Responsible for inventory, distribution, and ordering supplies and/or equipment for operational needs.
- Prepare Purchase Orders and receipt documents to submit to Accounting; and offers details for O&V reporting.
- Assign duties to operators.
- Assist with coordination of Board of Health inspections of production facilities.
- Prepare and coordinates preparation for Annual Compliance Sampling Inspections of wastewater facilities.
- Provide production records required for the Division of Water Resources.
- Maintain a working knowledge of all systems in assigned area in order to temporarily replace absent operators.
- On-call and/or work weekends and shifts as scheduled to maintain compliance with Company and regulatory agency guidelines required.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent, required.
- Ten years of experience as a water/wastewater plant operator preferred.
- Valid Motor Vehicle License.
- Must possess a Delaware Base Level Drinking Water Operator's License with endorsements.
- Must possess a Delaware Level II Wastewater License to perform Multi-plant operations.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Good mechanical and electrical skills; understanding of electronic controls.
- Ability to read blue prints.
- Proficient with MS Word and MS Excel.
- Proficient with company software for accounting within 3 months.
