Job Title: Construction Inspector

Job Summary:

The Construction Inspector inspects all new water and wastewater plant and distribution/collection system construction projects and sees that all new construction is performed to TUI's specifications. Also, the Construction Inspector coordinates the installation of new construction service laterals, as well as system shut downs with the Distribution Department. This position reports to the Director of Engineering.

Work Performed:

1. Responsible for inspection of all new water and wastewater plant and distribution/collection system construction.
2. Make sure that contractors perform work to Tidewater's standards and specifications.
3. Assist in planning improvements of existing distribution systems as well as new systems.
4. Responsible for reviewing blue prints for service material, ordering, preparing and receiving related purchase orders for materials and installation of same for new distribution system projects.
5. Hold necessary pre-construction and project meetings.
6. Schedule work for special projects.
7. Provide technical and field support to Engineering, and other company departments.
8. Prepare periodic project status reports to project managers and/or Director of Engineering.
9. Prepare weekly timesheets distributing labor to appropriate job and cost codes.
10. Participate in regularly scheduled staff meetings.
11. Observe and document pressure testing of all new construction.
12. Prepare construction as-builts and collect GPS data for all system components.
13. Perform fire flow tests.
14. Perform related duties as required.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent, required.
- Minimum of five years of experience in water utility or related construction field.
- Knowledge of supervisory techniques, project management or construction management.
- Valid driver's license.
- Knowledge of the interpretation or application of local, state and federal laws, rules, regulations, policies and procedures.
- Ability to read and interpret construction drawings.
- Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Ability to work under field conditions in a construction environment.
- Lifting and moving materials up to 50 lbs.
- Night and weekend overtime may be required to coordinate with construction schedules.
