### Job Summary:

Under the supervision of the Superintendent of Production or Production Foreman, the Assistant Mechanic maintains, monitors and operates production facilities and distribution system flows and pressures. These responsibilities require the utilization of SCADA monitoring and control equipment, local control panel units and local equipment operational controls. The Assistant Mechanic also performs daily inspections and checks equipment at the water treatment plant and well field. Will perform routine and emergency repairs to all of the chemical feed systems, equipment and pumps. The successful candidate will be passionate about supporting and driving the Company's Values, **RIGHT**: Respect, Integrity, Growth, Honesty and Teamwork.

### Work Performed:

- Performs daily inspections at all production facilities including: pumps, motors, buildings, electrical equipment and chemical feed equipment.
- Perform all duties required to maintain a clean, safe and sanitary work area.
- Assists the Production Foreman during the day shift with all preventative and emergency equipment repairs.
- Performs general housekeeping at facilities: cleaning, moping, washing etc.
- Performs general landscaping at facilities: cutting grass, weed wacking, vegetation clearing, etc.
- Performs snow removal, hand shoveling and snow plowing when required.
- Maintains company vehicles in a clean and safe condition.
- Performs start up and shutdown of well pumps as required.
- Operates the Runyon Treatment Plant using the SCADA control computer and the local control equipment as required.
- Maintains and monitors water treatment process through the addition and adjustment of water treatment chemicals in order to meet changing raw water quality.

- Performs laboratory testing as required to monitor water treatment process.
- Will work rotating shifts, including weekends and holidays when needed. Note that some mandatory overtime may be required as necessary to maintain facility operations.
- Perform other related duties as required by the Superintendent of Production or Production Foreman.
- Assist with the operation of the Residual Facilities when required.
- Ability to operate and or be trained in the operation of all heavy equipment: frontend loader, backhoe, skid steer, lawn tractor.
- Required to be available for on call purposes for Plant and facility emergencies, on short notice and emergency overtime situations.

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- At least 4 years' experience in plant, motor, electrical and pump maintenance operation.
- At least 2 years' experience operating a water treatment facility.
- Holds at least a T-1 water treatment license or have the ability to obtain one.
- Must maintain a valid motor vehicle license.
- Possession of a valid CDL license is desirable.
- Ability to speak, read, write and understand English.
