

PROGRESS UPDATE!

We are pleased to announce that we are no longer producing water from the wellfield that was testing above state limits for the new PFOA standard. The wells have been shut down and we are currently replacing that water supply with alternate sources that comply with all state and federal drinking water standards.

HOW DID WE GET HERE?

Recently completed upgrades to our infrastructure allow us to bypass the affected wells while meeting customer demand. After significant testing and sample analysis, we are reporting that water being delivered to customers is no longer coming from the wells which tested over the standard.

WHAT'S NEXT?

We intend to continue using alternate sources of water supply until the new water treatment plant in South Plainfield, currently under construction, is online in mid-2023. The upgraded facility has been designed to comply with New Jersey's stringent PFOA standards.

You should be aware that unforeseen emergencies could require us to turn the wells on prior to the completion of construction. We will be closely monitoring this approach should challenges arise and pledge to keep you updated on any developments.

As required by regulation, you will be receiving another Public Notification in the coming weeks that our wells again tested above permitted PFOA levels. This is because we utilized these wells during the earlier part of the fourth quarter of 2021. Please know that the wells have since been shut down and are no longer producing water.

We hope you can enjoy peace of mind knowing your drinking water is now being supplied from an alternate compliant source.
